


Project Outline

This is a major programme of work, spilt across two phases of development and with a commitment to pilot and conduct ongoing research and evaluation activities until 2026.

- Phase 1 consists of new developments in three curriculum areas
- Phase 2 consists of new developments in eight curriculum areas
 - In Phase 2, some developments will be led by centres and some by SQA development teams.

In both Phase 1 and Phase 2, iterative evaluation approaches are in place throughout to ensure that developments will meet the needs of the user.




Not intended to be prescriptive and restrict choice, but instead support the design of the qualification within 'flexible fences'

- HNC and HND discrete qualifications -120 SCQF credit points (15 SQA credits) at L7/8
- Development of Integrated meta-skills visible, evidenced and significant
- Larger and fewer units with significant reduction in assessment load for both learners and staff - Increased focus on learning and development
- Use of technology embedded to enhance and support assessment, learning and teaching approaches
- Graded units OUT Qualification grading



GRADING


- New models of grading are being tested as part of these prototype qualifications

- Prototype grading narratives provide overview on each grade


