
What is the ADVANCE Network?



- Collective group of Scottish Universities and Colleges
- ADVANCE wishes to highlight that any member of the armed forces community can consider education as a viable option and will be supported to do so by the institutions who are part of the network.
- The armed forces community includes current serving personnel, transitioning (from service) personnel, veterans, wives/partners of serving personnel, forces children, Wounded/ Injured/ Sick (WIS) personnel and early service leavers.
- Each University and College has a dedicated Armed Forces Lead within their institution. This person is responsible for establishing and leading a small team of knowledgeable individuals (familiar with the Armed Forces community).

Why do we need ADVANCE?



- In November 2016 the Scottish Veterans Commissioner issued a report entitled *The Veterans Community-Employability, Skills and Learning* which advises Scottish Ministers on improving employment and learning opportunities for the Armed Forces Community.
- The Scottish Funding Council were given a number of recommendations relating to education to action/fulfil
- SFC Armed Forces & Veterans Community Group (AFVCG) was created was formed



APPLYING TO UNIVERSITY THROUGH UCAS



This is the process for applying to universities in the UK.

- Open University are done directly to those institutions.
- Part Time routes for most universities may not require a UCAS application. Get in touch with the Admissions team or Veterans Champion for more information

UCAS:

- Web-based system
- Includes details of your qualifications and a personal statement
- You can apply to up to five courses
- Application sessions run by universities & UCAS
